Media Arabic introduces the language of print and Internet news media in Arabic. It will be possible for the students to master the core vocabulary and structure typical for front-page news stories and critically read news in Arabic. News Articles, mostly online and printed when available will be discussed in this class: Talks and Conferences, Demonstrations and Protests, Conflicts and Terrorism, Elections, Rule of Law, and Business; as well as other topic that we find interesting.

Students at the end of the course will be able to read and understand extended news related texts with greater accuracy.
